Overview

Blacktown RSL Club wanted to give its members a whole new look to its existing gaming lounge, which was also to incorporate and implement more player privacy achieved through an improved layout and screens. The brief was also to increase space to increase the number of machines to the outdoor gaming lounge.

Network Refurbishments & Construction worked closely with the Club's Gaming Consultant Tony Donnelly.

Minimising Disruption

As the project was taking place within the existing gaming lounge, the client needed Network Refurbishments & Construction to ensure minimal disruption to its gaming operation and Club patrons. Timely Delivery
